About the Foyer Gallery

The Gallery has over 600 square feet of glassed-in space located in the front foyer of the Nepean Sportsplex at 1701 Woodroffe Avenue. Annual traffic for the Nepean Sportsplex is 1.1 million visitors.

Foyer Gallery is a not-for-profit, artist-run exhibit space, operated under the auspices of the Nepean Visual Art Centre Advisory Committee (NVAC-AC).

The Foyer Gallery Artists' Association (FGAA) promotes and provides a venue for local artists to exhibit high quality original art in a variety of media.

Revenues are generated from Annual Membership fees (currently \$50 per year) and 15% commission on the sale of exhibited artwork.

Jury Process

Applications are juried in an arm's length peer review done by a minimum of three professional artists. Acceptance is based on originality, quality and excellence of the art work, **AND** on the applicant's willingness to participate in the operation of the Gallery. Participation in this co-operative gallery is mandatory.

Application requirements

Please submit the following by 5:00 p.m., January 27, 2008

- 1- A \$25.00 non-refundable jury fee (cheque payable to: NVAC-AC, FGAA).
- 2- A signed application form with your name, address, city, postal code and phone numbers at home and at work, your e-mail address and your medium of artwork.
- 3- Artist's CV and artist statement.
- 4- 10 digital images (Jpeg and PC compatible only) on CD (1024 pixels maximum on the longest side) showing your most recent work (within 2 years). Label the slides with the number from 01 to 10 and title the work (Ex.: 01-Image title).
- 5- Provide a correspondingly numbered list of the slides/images with the title, year of completion, dimensions, medium and techniques used.
- 6- Include a self-addressed envelope for the return of your slides or CD.

NB: Slide quality and image quality are extremely important in the artwork jury process. A Power Point presentation will cancel your submission.

Jury Decision

Applicants will be notified of the jury's decision in mid-February 2008.
